Policy No. 807

LARGE POWER

I. OBJECTIVE

To establish the rate to be charged for all large power services effective 5/1/2017.

II. CONTENT

A. This rate class shall be applied to all three phase services that go over 50kW of non-coincidental demand 6 or more times in a calendar year or has an installed service large enough to serve a load over 200kva of non-coincidental demand. The monthly non-coincidental kW demand will be reviewed annually to determine continued large power rate eligibility.

B. The monthly rate shall be as follows:

Facility charge	\$ 100.00
Energy charge per kWh	
First Rate Block - see D. below	\$.079
Excess kWh's	\$.043
Coincidental demand charge per kW	\$ 19.00
<i>Plus applicable taxes</i>	

C. The minimum monthly charge shall be the facility charge plus applicable tax.

D. The first rate block of the monthly energy shall be determined by multiplying the non-coincidental peak kW demand by 100 and applying a rate of .079. All additional kWh's shall be billed at the excess rate.

E. The member's monthly coincidental demand shall be equal to the kW demand the member contributes coincident with the monthly thirty minute billing demand from the cooperative's power supplier as measured by the cooperative's meter. The coincidental demand charge shall be applied to the member's coincident kW demand.

F. Those members receiving street lighting shall have the street lighting charge added to their bill.

G. The cooperative will, at the member's request, provide the member a notification device to alert the member of possible load control events within the East River Electric Power Cooperative system to allow the member to voluntary reduce their usage during peak demand periods.

H. In the event of an increase or decrease in the cooperative's wholesale power cost the cooperative may adjust the member's monthly bill to account for the change in its wholesale cost of power.


III. Responsibility

The Manager shall be responsible for carrying out the provisions of this policy.


